

## **FUNERAL OF GRAHAM MAULE**

Graham's funeral service will take place on Friday 10th January at 11.00 in St Mary's Episcopal Cathedral, 300 Great Western Rd, Glasgow G4 9JB.

The Burial will follow at Craufurdland Natural Woodland Burial Ground, near Fenwick in Ayrshire. Directions will be given at the funeral, or see: <https://craufurdland.co.uk/burial-ground/>

Those going to the burial – please bring footwear (wellies!) suitable for wet ground.

Thereafter there will be a time for meeting and light refreshments in the auditorium at Oran Mor, which is at the Botanic Gardens junction of Great Western Rd and Byres Rd, G12 8QX, from 14.30 to 18.30.

### **The Cathedral.**

By foot, St Mary's Cathedral is equidistant from St George's Cross and Kelvinbridge subway stations.

By car from the East, take the M8 and turn off at Junction 17 for Dumbarton A82. At the end of the slip road turn right and cross the bridge onto Great Western Rd. There is car parking on either side of the road between 09.00 and 16.00, but it might be best to head 400 yards to Napiershall St which is on the right just before the Cathedral.

There are several streets to the left and fewer to the right where you might find parking spaces. Parking may also be had on Maryhill Rd which is the final right turn from the far end of Napiershall St. Burnbank Gardens and Terrace are near the Cathedral and are accessible at exits from Maryhill Rd.

By car from the South. Take the M8 and keep left crossing the Kingston Bridge, taking the slip road at Junction 17 for Dumbarton A82. The slip road feeds onto Great Western Rd. Turn right onto Napiershall St at the first set of lights, just before the Cathedral.

All parking on both sides of Great Western Rd is metered. It is 20p per 15 minutes for the first hour and 40p per 15 minutes for subsequent hours to a maximum of three hours. The machines take 20p, 50p, £1 and £2 coins only.

St Mary's has toilet facilities immediately to the left on entering the Cathedral.
